Alex MacLeod/Gib McIlwrath moved that The Interim Moderator, The Rev. Mark Gaskin be dismissed with the thanks of the Court but remain on as mentor for a minimum of one year.

BENEDICTION:

It was agreed that the Presbytery would conclude when the Benediction is pronounced at the end of the service.

EDICT AND NARRATION OF STEPS:

The Clerk, Wilma Welsh, entered the Sanctuary and read the Edict. The Edict was also read on November 13th & 20th at St. Andrew's Hespeler.

SERVICE, INDUCTION AND SIGNING THE FORMULA:

The Court entered the sanctuary singing the Processional Hymn. The service was led by The Rev. Mark Gaskin, with the Rev. Ed. Charlton delivering the message and charge.

The Clerk read the Narration of Steps and presented the Rev. Scott McAndless to the Moderator. With the appointed preamble and questions, the Rev. John Borthwick inducted the Rev. Scott McAndless into the pastoral charge of St. Andrew's (Hespeler) Presbyterian Church, Cambridge.

The Presbytery was then called forward to give the right hand of fellowship after which the Formula was signed. The Session of St. Andrew's Hespeler was then invited to extend the right hand of fellowship.
